

# 2011-2012 SSP Individual Yearbook Contest Info and Entry Submission Rules

## Individual Yearbook Entry Guidelines

- Only items created (stories, photos, designs, etc.) by students currently on staff are eligible for submission. This means materials from the 2010-11 yearbook, as well as materials being created for the 2011-12 yearbook are eligible.
- Only SSP member schools may enter the contest
- Each school may submit no more than **15** total individual entries and a maximum of **3** per category
- Each entry must include a tear sheet from the 2010 yearbook or a high quality print
- Each entry must have the **Individual Yearbook Entry ID** filled out completely and stapled in the upper left corner
- Copy and photo entries must be circled or otherwise noted on the spread
- Please tape together and fold DPS; fold all full DPS sheets
- Entries that are not submitted correctly will be disqualified
- Bundle contest entries together and place the **Individual Yearbook Submission Record** on top
- Send payment/PO with the **Contest Payment Form** to Otto Schultejeans, SSP Treasurer (info on form)
- Entry forms and material may be hand delivered at the SSP meeting on **Jan. 11** at Clayton High School
- Entry forms and material may be postmarked by **Jan. 6** so they arrive by **Jan. 11**, to:

## Individual Yearbook Categories/Descriptions

- **People/Classes Design (Y1)**: a double-page spread including student portraits and add'l coverage
- **Sports Design (Y2)**: a double-page spread focusing on sports coverage
- **Student Life Design (Y3)**: a double-page spread focusing on events, student life, academics or activities coverage
- **Theme Development (Y4)**: submit the cover, endsheets, title page, a division spread and an opening spread with opening copy
- **Sports Copy (Y5)** : Submit any sports story and its accompanying spread
- **Feature Copy (Y6)**: Submit a student life, academics, activities or special section story and its accompanying spread
- **Yearbook Sports Photography (YP 1)**: Photos should emphasize the action or feature elements of any sports event.
- **Yearbook Photography (YP 2)**: This category can include any photo from an event, activity, academic or student life spread.
